Workshop room attendant

Check attendees in, assist teachers, direct workshop attendees to next class.

SSF Welcome center/merch table attendants

Sell SSF merch and give info/directions to attendees.

Set Up Team

Help set up workshop rooms, stages and vendors unload

Break down Team

Help breakdown workshop rooms, stages and vendors load up

Street team – to be done the first week of September

Put out flyers, posters and hand bills.

Stage Managers
